

Progress Report – City of St. Petersburg West Central Village Project



West Central Village is on the move! The Board would like to keep you up to date on our progress. Look over the accomplishments below that have taken place over the last six months.

- West Central Village (WCV) logo was created (see above)
- \$50,000. has been placed in the City Budget to design a streetscape plan
- A 504C3 nonprofit status is underway to enable WCV to solicit corporate sponsors and seek membership contributions
- WCV Facebook Page is being created by our Marketing Committee. The purpose of the page is to connect and promote businesses within the WCV to broader St. Pete. Based on the Central Avenue Revitalization Plan, West Central Village includes businesses on Central Avenue between 58th St - Park Street.
- The Board has met with a city planner, city engineer and the project contractor to provide input on the design of the phase one streetscape
- the Board has met with the Art in Transit initiative to provide input
- WCV will be co-sponsoring the Autumn Arts Festival with the Jungle Terrace Civic Association in Sunset Park on October 12 10:00am - 5pm. Please see attached flyer for additional information and registration.
